This project involves the Australian East Coast transport operation for one of the world's largest automotive manufacturers. ASCAP rents Loscam's Gpak stillages on behalf of this OEM in order to move its spare parts and accessories across the network of dealerships in Australia.

The project is a success, all parties are very pleased with the results. After Loscam fitted the assets with Thinxtra's IoT track and trace solution, the leading automotive provider is now able to gain a significant cost saving through ASCAP being able to reduce the amount of assets on hire in the network.

early statistics around cost-saving and limiting losses are impressive, it's about more than just the tracking. This is really powerful data that can help shape business processes, reduce bottlenecks, manage delivery times, assess risk, compliance, the opportunities are endless."
